ABOUT THE RACE

Nothing breathes life into a frigid winter day like sailing across the frozen ground in a homemade porta potty. Just ask those in attendance at our event in 2022, held at The Smiling Moose in Newton.

For those unfamiliar with the ins and outs of porta potty racing, the official rules state that all competing lavatories have three walls and a toilet seat, leaving room for a wide range of design strategies to slip and flip. Participants build their own racing loos, homemade structures built atop skis, so their porta-potties level up from portable to race-able. Within each unique exterior sits a courageous “driver,” operating the latrine with nerves of steel-- not that they have any control. The true feats of athleticism and balance are performed by the racing teams, three or fewer member crews that push and pull their contraptions 30 yards to cross the finish line.

It's no small feat racing an outhouse—or watching someone else do it from the sidelines. Our event provides the fuel all day long, serving food, drinks, raffles, and family fun.



ABOUT LAKESHORE FOSTER FAMILIES & FRIENDS

This event is the primary fundraiser for our organization for the year. In 2022 this event raised over \$10,000 helping support the many children in out-of-home care and the families providing for them.

LFFF was founded with the compelling need to improve the lives of the many children and families involved in the foster care system. Identifying an opportunity to promote the well-being of children in our community, this organization sought to close the gaps in services and community resources. Our goal is to make sure every placement provider has the resources they need to fill the existing gaps in services and community resources in order to meet each child's needs.



Our birthday program is projected to provide 72 children a birthday cake and \$25 gift.

Care Kits are packed for all ages of children being placed into care. These kits include clothing, essential items, hygiene products, school supplies, activities, and pantry items. So far in 2022, we have packed 48 Care Kits.

Our Care Closet is available to the 95 families we serve providing children in care with any needs they may have including school supplies, clothing, hygiene products, etc. So far in 2022, we have seen 74 visits to the Closet. We pride ourselves on only having new items to help build self-esteem in their young lives.



TEAM REGISTRATION



The cost of registration is \$40 per team. Please register and pay online at www.lakeshorefosterfamilies.org, or mail your completed registration form and a check made payable to Lakeshore Foster Families & Friends, 1011 Washington Street, Suite 6, Manitowoc, WI 54220.

Teams of up to 5 members, and a minimum of 3, will assemble their own customized "porta potty" to race down a snowy strip. The winner is determined with bracket races and will take home the trophy and prizes!

Requirements for you porta potty: must resemble an outhouse, must have a seat with a hole, and must resemble be equipped with wiping paraphernalia (toilet paper, corn cobs, junk mail, leaves, etc.), a push bar, and a rider. No motors or cleats are allowed. This event will happen, rain, snow, or shine!
